This week, we bring to you information regarding the Grandfathered Plans of the Health Plan Requirements communicated last week. These Grandfathered Plans are only subject to a limited number of requirements as a result of the recently-enacted health care reform laws.

- The definition of grandfathered plans
- New enrollments in grandfathered plans permitted
- Reforms that apply to all grandfathered plans
- Reforms that apply to grandfathered plans that are "group health plans"
- Effective dates
- "Grace period" but no grandfathering for certain collectively-bargained plans
- Reforms that do not apply to grandfathered plans.
